All EAF member Clubs are invited to take part in one or both Inter-Club Championships at

EAF INTER-CLUB PROJECTED DIGITAL IMAGE CHAMPIONSHIP on Sunday 9th February 2020

and

EAF INTER-CLUB PRINT CHAMPIONSHIP on Sunday 8th March 2020

**Judges: Gwen Charnock FRPS MFIAP, Phil Charnock FRPS MFIAP
and David Lowe ARPS DPAGB**

These two separate events will find the top Projected Digital Image (PDI) Club and the top Print Club in the Federation. They will also select two Clubs to represent our Federation at the PAGB Inter-Club PDI Championship held at Warwick University on 11th July 2020 and the PAGB Inter-Club Print Championship held on 25th October 2020 in Blackburn (venue to be confirmed).

Competition secretaries, please treat your application as a commitment to enter and ensure your committee and membership are in agreement that you are confident, before applying, that you will be able to select the required 25 PDIs and/or 25 Print Images for these Championships. Please note, if your Club is one of the Clubs selected at the EAF Championships to represent the EAF at the PAGB PDI or Print Inter-Club Championship later in the year, your members whose work is used in the EAF Championships MUST continue to support your Club in the PAGB Championships: they can only represent one Club, from any Federation, at the PAGB PDI or Print Club Championship in any one year.

Please note that the entry procedure for both Championships is similar to last year, with the Print Championship requiring BOTH entry form **AND titles list** in Word-compatible format to be sent in by the closing date. Each Championship has a closing date three weeks prior to the date of that Championship. Clubs must have paid their 2020 EAF subscription to take part in the 2020 Championships.

Late entries will not be accepted. (Championships Rule 1.)

Calendar:

Sunday 19th January 2020: Closing date for PDI entry. Your PDI entry form and titles list in Word-compatible format plus the 25 images must be

- posted (on a CD)
- emailed (Round One and Round Two separately please)
- or sent to me by Dropbox or WeTransfer

and must arrive by 19th January. Early entries are always appreciated.

Sunday 9th February 2020 - PDI Championship, The Fulbourn Centre

Championship will be after the EAF AGM at 10am – Championship starts no earlier than 11am

Sunday 16th February 2020 - Closing date for Print entry. Print entry form and titles list only in Word-compatible format required, by post (on a CD) or email.

Note: Print labels required for the Print Championships will be given out at the PDI Championships to those Clubs whose entry form and titles list have been received before 5th February. Labels will be sent by post to those Clubs whose entry form and titles list are received between 5th and 16th February.

Sunday 8th March 2020: Print Championship, The Fulbourn Centre - 10.45am

Your 25 Print images (**which must match your titles list submitted on or before 16th February**) must be handed in **between 9.15am and 9.45am** on 8th March.

Please read the Championship rules carefully. PDIs must be correctly submitted according to the instructions given with the Rules, and Prints must be on mounts 50cm x 40cm.

You may be aware that the EAF has purchased a new projector enabling 1600 x 1200 pixels to be used as the maximum image size in line with The PAGB. Note that 1400 x 1050 will still be accepted, though it will appear proportionately smaller when projected on screen.

The 4-year rule is not necessary for this competition and has proved impractical to police so it has been deleted.

The use of data for the Championships will comply with the EAF's Data Protection Policy as displayed on the EAF Website and is also available on the Downloadable Documents page.

Please note that no photography or videoing of the images entered is allowed during the Championships.
