## **EAF INTER-CLUB PRINT CHAMPIONSHIP**

on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2022

These two separate events will find the top Projected Digital Image (PDI) Club and the top Print Club in the Federation. They will also select two Clubs to represent our Federation at the PAGB Inter-Club PDI Championship held at Warwick University in July 2022 and the PAGB Inter-Club Print Championship held in October 2022 (venue to be advised).

Competition secretaries, please treat your application as a commitment to enter and ensure your committee and membership are in agreement that you are confident, <u>before applying</u>, that you will be able to select the required 25 PDIs and/or 15 Print Images for these Championships. Please note, if your Club is one of the Clubs selected at the EAF Championships to represent the EAF at the PAGB PDI or Print Inter-Club Championship later in the year, your members whose work is used in the EAF Championships MUST continue to support your Club in the PAGB Championships: they can only represent one Club, from any Federation, at the PAGB PDI or Print Club Championship in any one year.

This year the Print Championship will only call for 15 images rather than 25. This is in line with the PAGB Inter-Club Print Championship and is intended to enable a wider range of Clubs to enter and encourage the use of prints.

The Championships early in 2021 were cancelled due the pandemic but we intend to hold them in 2022 with some limitations. The venue currently restricts the number of people in the main hall to about half that we have managed in recent years. They also operate a one-way system in the corridors and they ask that face masks and social distancing are adhered to when queuing for access, moving about in the

corridors and accessing the toilets. Covid-19 Secure Guidelines are shown on posters at the venue and these should be followed. Surfaces likely to be touched will be cleaned before and after the event.

The capacity limitations mean that tickets to each event will be limited initially to two per Club entering, to be requested by the Club Competition Secretary when the Club's entry has been submitted and before the entry closing date. Any remaining tickets will then be available on general sale to anyone who applies. In order to cater for those unable to obtain tickets or who might still feel uncomfortable attending, the competition will be available on Zoom. Tickets will still be required as these are limited to 100 and a charge will be made. Tickets may now be purchased by email with payment by BACS and all tickets purchased will be sent by email. Separate applications should be made for the two Championships.

<u>Please note</u> that the entry procedure for both Championships is similar to 2020, with the Print Championship requiring BOTH Entry Form <u>AND Titles List</u> in Word-compatible format to be sent in by the closing date. Each Championship has a closing date three weeks prior to the date of that Championship. Clubs must have paid their 2022 EAF subscription to take part in the 2022 Championships.

#### Late entries will not be accepted. (Championships Rule 1.)

Sunday 13th February 2022 - PDI Championship, The Fulbourn Centre

Championship will be after the EAF AGM at 10.30am – Championship starts no earlier than 11.30am

**Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2022** - Closing date for Print entry. Print Entry Form and Titles List only in Word-compatible format required, by email or post (on a CD).

**Note:** Print labels required for the Print Championship will be given out at the PDI Championship to those Clubs whose entry form and titles list have been received before 9<sup>th</sup> February. Labels will be sent by post to the remaining Clubs.

Sunday 13th March 2022: Print Championship, The Fulbourn Centre - 10.45am

Your 15 Print images (which must match your Titles List submitted on or before 20<sup>th</sup> February) must be handed in between 9.15am and 9.45am on 13<sup>th</sup> March.

Please read the Championship rules carefully. PDIs must be correctly submitted according to the instructions given with the Rules, and Prints must be on mounts 50cm x 40cm.

For PDIs, 1600 x 1200 pixels will be used as the maximum image size in line with The PAGB. Note that 1400 x 1050 will still be accepted, though it will appear proportionately smaller when projected on screen.

The use of data for the Championships will comply with the EAF's Data Protection Policy. This is available on the EAF Website on the Downloadable Documents page.

Please note that no photography or videoing of the images entered is allowed during the Championships.
